Request for holiday leave

The school has recently had a number of requests for holiday leave during term time. Please read the guidance provided to schools by the DfE.

The law does not grant parents the automatic right to take their child out of school during term time. Only <u>exceptional circumstances</u> warrant an authorised leave of absence. The school will consider each application individually, considering the specific facts and circumstances and relevant background context behind the request. The request must be made by the parent with whom the child lives, and permission must be sought in advance. The school will not grant leave unless there are exceptional circumstances apply.

• Financial reasons are NOT an exceptional circumstance

It is the view of the Local Authority that restrictions arising as a result of being selfemployed are NOT an exceptional circumstance.
The Head teacher should consider whether the absence coincides with statutory assessments.

The school must be satisfied that there are exceptional circumstances based on the individual facts and circumstances of the case; following consultation with other staff as required, including the Designated Safeguarding Lead. Where a leave of absence is granted the school will determine the number of days the pupil can be away from school. A leave of absence is granted entirely at the Head teacher's discretion.

Circumstances which could be authorised include significant family emergencies or funerals. Parents should complete a Leave of Absence Request form which is available from the school office. The request should be submitted promptly; and wherever possible, at least four weeks before the absence.

If the attendance of the pupil is below 95%, or there has been repeated leave of absence for holidays, <u>we will not authorise absence in term</u> <u>time- exceptional circumstances or not</u>. Next newsletter: Friday 23rd June 2023.
