School tours and parent/carer drop ins

Thank you to those that came for our school tours. It was really lovely to show you round, and the feedback from the tours was very positive. We will plan another tour at the start of the new academic year (provisionally booked, 12.09.23).

School reports will go out next Friday 14th July, and parents/carers are invited to 'drop in' to see their child's classteacher if the wish to discuss the content of their report on Monday 17th July.

There is no booking system to this, please wander up to the classroom and the teachers will be available to discuss any queries paremts/carers may have. We appreciate most parents/carers will not need to speak to their child's class teacher as the report will provide enough information already.

Class structures and 2023-24

On the next page, is the outline of the class structures for next year. Many may notice that we have one class less- notably in KS1.

As a result in having two smaller cohorts (next year's Reception and Year 1) we have had to reduce the number of classes. The combined

numbers in Reception and KS1 have had to be mixed so we will have two Reception/Year 1, and two Year 1/Year 2 classes. Obviously, we would have prefered to have classes with no mixed year groups. However, with the numbers we have in these year groups, we could not do so without going above 30 children.

On the positive side, by having four classes with a Year 1 mix, we are able to pool planning, resources and staff across the age range. This includes smaller phonics and intervention groups, as well as access to an additional classroom space for each KS1 class. All Year 1 children will have access to the same curriculum provision with the added bonus that staff that we can now group teach key year groups in smaller numbers. Those Year 1's in Red/Grey Squirrels will have a combined session in the afternoon designated to the Foundation subjects (e.g. History, Geography, Science etc.)

We have also moved some staff, giving opportunities for teachers and Teaching Assistants to gain experience of working across the age range.

We will share the September starting arrangements in the final newsletter of the academic year.
