
The CDs arrived in beautiful full colour, wrapped in a printed, eco-friendly sleeve and all sold out within a week. All money raised will go towards improving our school!

The questions were extremely challenging this year and all four children worked fantastically as a team. Keep up the hard work, you have made Wellsprings proud!




We have continued the migration to our new website at:
