We have replaced the playground equipment on the corner of the KS2 playground over the summer. The children are really enjoying get their time on it!

As we mentioned before the break, Pentagon Play will undertake a refit of the rest of the playground, with zoned areas for netball/basketball and football, and we will replace the timtrail at the rear of the playground as it is now rotten. It should look amazing, with further plans for the KS1 playground later on in the year.

We hope the fenced areas around KS1, KS2 and the front patio will help to 'organise' these spaces and give each Key Phase a bit more definition. It certainly looks neater.



However, we now have an 'injury' to the bridge on the KS1 playground, which we hope to fix as soon as possible. We suspect some of the damage to this happened over the summer break, from local children visiting the school site. As

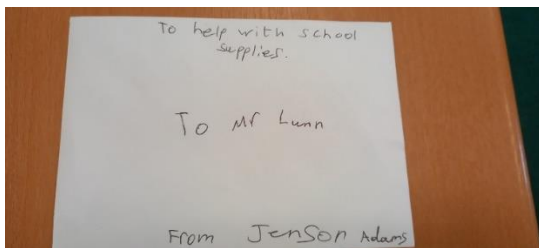
we mentioned on our Facebook page, we had a lot of vandalism to the school this summer. Additionally, our Forest School equipment was pretty much destroyed, two windows in TOG and at Wellsprings were broken along with a fence in the Foundation Stage.

It is very frustrating especially as we have invested heavily towards improving the school environment only for our good work to be undone.

We have provided the police with further information and hope they can continue to support the school, and local community in tackling anti-social behaviour.

We will be working with other local schools and providers to look at ways to reduce these incidents occurring. More information to come in the future!
